Starting at 7pm Thursday April 22nd in the old church, HTMA will renew its monthly coffeehouse series with this fine trio consisting of fine genuine old-time musicians **Joseph DeCosimo** from Chattanooga, **Luke Richardson** from Lawrenceburg, and Huntsville's own **Edwin Wilson**. Amongst the three, we have TWO National Old-time Banjo Champions, one Alabama Oldtime Fiddle Champion, a National Appalachian Stringband Champion, Old-time Herald contributors, dance band performers, and field collectors. Dave has spent time with surviving old-time musicians such as Charlie Acuff learning their material and passing it on in like fashion. Dave was instrumental in organizing the National Banjo Institute, the Nashville Old-time String Band Association, and several festivals and contests throughout middle Tennessee. Come hear Dave's eclectic clawhammer banjo and baritone voice in the old way.
